[The Clinical Neuroscience Lab](#), in the Department of Psychology, within the College of Arts and Sciences, seeks a research associate to join our team. The Clinical Neuroscience Lab is directed by Dr. Ruchika Prakash and the laboratory is funded by the National Institute of Health and the National Multiple Sclerosis Society. The lab is currently conducting a number of randomized controlled trials, examining the effects of lifestyle interventions on cognitive and brain plasticity, in older adults and individuals with multiple sclerosis. The successful candidate will assist Dr. Prakash in the everyday activities of the lab, including managing various research projects, supervising graduate students and full-time research assistants, assisting in data collection, and helping in clinical outreach activities of the lab.

Successful candidates must have earned master's degree in Psychology, with preference given to candidates with a doctorate in Psychology or Neuroscience. Additionally, the successful candidate should have prior experience working on research projects with multi-disciplinary teams, and be comfortable in managing longitudinal studies. Experience with statistical and/or neuroimaging analyses is desired.
